TO: ALL IMPORTERS

Please be informed that the clearance of goods under the general Bond for delivery of goods prior to the payment of duty (C46) will be discontinued effective February 1, 2012. All outstanding liabilities due on these Bonds must be paid by February 14, 2012 thereafter the Bond will be cancelled.

A reapplication process will commence from February 6, 2012 and only the following goods will be considered for clearance against the C46 Bond:

1. Perishable goods;
2. Raw materials imported by the manufacturing sector;
3. Goods qualifying for concessions under any authority;
4. Other goods requiring delivered in special circumstances, with the permission of the Comptroller of Customs.

Please note that only eligible applicants with no outstanding liabilities will be granted approval for use of this facility. Qualifying Importers must therefore reapply to the Comptroller on the prescribed form.

Please be guided accordingly.
