CONDITIONS FOR THE PROVISION OF OVERTIME SERVICES

Please be informed that the provision of overtime services is governed by the Customs Regulations Cap.1505 of the Revised Laws of Saint Lucia 2006 and the Collective Agreement between the Government of St. Lucia and the Civil Service Association.

Further be informed that as a condition for the grant of an application to perform overtime services, the following shall apply:

Where the services of the officer are required during the meal hours of 12 noon to 1:00pm and 7:00pm to 8:00pm, a meal allowance of \$22.00 shall be paid to the officer by the person requesting the service.

Where the services of the officer are required during the meal hour of 7:00am – 8:00am, a meal allowance of EC\$15.00 shall be paid to the officer by the person requesting the service.

In all case where the services of an officer are required outside Customs House suitable transportation for the officer shall be provided by the person requesting the service.

Customs Notice No. 3 of 2008 is hereby repealed.

Please be guided accordingly.
